



SPRING 2012 • Classes begin January 23

All first-time-in-any-College students with the goal of degree or transfer are required to complete Orientation, Assessment, and Academic Advising before registering for Spring 2012 classes.

Out-of-Area Students may use the following information to make plans for completing Assessment and in-person Academic Advising in one trip over a two or three day period.

Note: out-of-area students may alternately choose to complete Assessment at their convenience during **any** drop-in testing day (hours and dates posted at sbcc.edu/assessment) and complete Advising online at sbcc.edu/counselingcenter/advising.php. Students may also enroll in classes online.

Read through the following information about Orientation, Assessment and Academic Advising and then consult the chart on page 2 to plan your trip to Santa Barbara.

1) ORIENTATION

- Must be completed online at sbcc.edu/orientation

2) ASSESSMENT

- In general, testing for Spring 2012 is offered Monday through Thursday on a drop-in basis (no appointment required) from October 31—January 27 in the Assessment Center Computer Lab.
- **Consult the chart on the following page to plan a day and time to come to Santa Barbara and test.** Classes fill up quickly, therefore it is important to test as soon as is reasonably possible based on your individual schedule and test availability. Testing on one of the specific dates listed on the next page will ensure that you have your placement results in time for an in-person Advising session.
- **Important:** if you need extended time on your test or another accommodation for disability, you must make arrangements with the Disabilities Specialists at Santa Barbara City College before testing. For more information, call the DSPS office at (805) 965-0581 x2364 or visit sbcc.edu/dsps.
- **Bring the following required items to testing:**
 - ✓ A completed REAP Test Preparation Form (available at sbcc.edu/assessment)
 - ✓ Photo Identification (Driver's License, passport, etc.)

3) ACADEMIC ADVISING

- Advising may be completed either **in-person** or **online:** sbcc.edu/counselingcenter/advising.php
- **In-person Advising** is provided by Academic Counselors in small group sessions. Space is limited and **an appointment is required:** consult the chart on the following page and make an appointment at sbcc.edu/counselingcenter/advising.php.
- English and Math placement results are required for students who want to register for classes during in-person Academic Advising.

NOTE:

- If you have completed Orientation online and received your Assessment test results you will be able to register for Spring 2012 classes during your in-person advising session, *provided that the advising session takes place on or after your individual Registration date.*
- **Advising and Registration may also be completed online, but you must come to Santa Barbara to complete Assessment.** *Note: You may come to test earlier than the dates listed above (check specific drop-in testing dates and times at sbcc.edu/assessment), but you will not be able to register for classes until your assigned registration date. To check your registration date, log onto your Pipeline account (<http://pipeline.sbcc.edu>) and click on "Check Your Registration Status." The date listed for you is the first day you are eligible to register. You may also register any day thereafter.*
