



# REAP *test preparation form*

Assessment of your skills in mathematics and English helps you achieve your goals in college by placing you into courses appropriate to your skill level. The steps on this form will guide you through the information necessary for a successful testing experience at SBCC.

## 1 Click on ALTERNATIVES TO TESTING to see if you need to test



If you are eligible for a math and/or English testing exemption, you must submit a **Prerequisite Challenge Form** for computer clearance: go to [sbcc.edu/prerequisitepolicy](http://sbcc.edu/prerequisitepolicy).

## 2 Choose your math test level: click on SAMPLE TEST QUESTIONS

You need to choose which one of the four math tests is most appropriate for you: Work through the sample problems; plan to take the highest numbered test that matches your math background and current skills.

## 3 Review for the MATH TEST

After choosing a math test (see step #2), you may purchase a **study packet** from the Campus Bookstore: (805) 963-4661. Students taking Test #3 or #4 may take an **online pretest** at <http://mdtp.ucsd.edu/onlinetests.shtml>.

## 4 Review for the ENGLISH TEST

Unlike math, most students don't 'study' for the English test, but you may find it helpful to familiarize yourself with the format of the test: download and review the **Sample English Test** from the Assessment website.

## 5 Choose when you plan to test: click on DROP-IN TESTING HOURS

**No appointment is necessary but all tests must be completed by closing:** allow 2 hours for English; 1-2 hours for math. If you live outside of the Santa Barbara area, be sure to click on **Out-of-Area Students** for additional information.

- Your SBCC student I.D. number (your 'K' number, which is available on Pipeline). *Write it here:*     **K00**

- Your name and date of birth exactly as they appear on your SBCC application. *Write them below:*
