I would like to share a few important pieces of information with you concerning (1) an upcoming budget forum to which members of the community are invited, (2) tuition assistance scholarships for winter 2012, and (3) achieving the vision of Continuing Education.

BUDGET FORUM OCT. 20

Acting Superintendent/President Dr. Jack Friedlander, Vice President of Business Services Joe Sullivan, and Vice President of Continuing Education Dr. Ofelia R. Arellano invite you to attend an upcoming budget forum on Thursday, October 20 from 5:30 to 6:30 p.m. at the Wake Center Auditorium. During the session they will give an overview of the SBCC 2011-2012 adopted budget and what steps the college will have to take to reach the required reductions due to cutbacks in State funding. They will also address issues of particular interest to Continuing Education students, staff and faculty. A question and answer period will follow the presentation.

This is important information to share with the Continuing Education community, and we hope that you will make an effort to attend. We request that people arrive on time in order to hear the entire presentation.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

The Continuing Education Division will once again award tuition scholarships to students who need financial help and wish to enroll in a tuition-based course for the Winter 2012 term. Here are the key dates for the application period:

Saturday, October 15: A list of classes requiring tuition fees for Winter will be posted to our website.

Monday, October 17: Application period begins. You can apply online, or download and print a pdf version from our website, or pick up a hard copy at Schott Center and Wake Center main offices.

Monday, November 21 (4:15 pm): DEADLINE FOR SUBMITTING SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS. Complete and submit the online application, OR submit a hard copy application to Schott or Wake Center main office.

Tuesday, November 22 - December 6: Scholarship Committee selects and notifies recipients.

Students who apply for tuition assistance must demonstrate financial need. The Scholarship Committee will give priority to applicants wishing to register for classes that are health related, life/social enrichment or needed due to special circumstances.
