CPC/DTC and Dr. Baltzer will identify the next steps in the web plan review and development. Meeting times will be scheduled for that review and development to take place.

Overview of Process for Ranking Resource Requests (PFE and other sources of funds)

- 1. Proposals will be reviewed and prioritized by workgroups. Work groups will review, where possible combine, and rank proposals in top, middle and lower-third priority. No more than one-third of the proposals can be placed in the top priority category.
 - Student Success: cross-functional team and reps from Matriculation and LSS
 - Faculty Professional Development: cross-functional team and reps from FEC
 - Instructional Technology: cross-functional team reps from ITC, Online faculty and Campus Pipeline pilot project faculty
 - Occupational/Technical Education: cross-functional team and chairs of occupational education departments
 - Enrollment Management Marketing: cross-functional team and Marketing Committee
- 2. CPC will review proposals identified as top priorities by the workgroups and make initial ranking of proposals into the top, middle and lower priority categories. No more than one-third of the requests will be placed in each of the three categories.
- 3. The committees will discuss proposals but not submit rankings to CPC. Committees will be asked to focus primarily on proposals CPC identified in the top third list of priorities.
