Official transcripts (in original sealed/unopened envelope) for all lower and upper division courses completed at any and all regionally accredited U.S. institutions, regardless of applicability to nursing requirements, will be required. <b>Failure to submit transcripts with all grades posted will result in disqualification of application.</b>  <b>Note:</b> Transcripts are not required for coursework completed at Santa Barbara City College.  Prerequisite courses completed at other regionally accredited United States colleges or universities must be equivalent to Santa Barbara City College courses. Course descriptions for prerequisite courses completed at a non-California Community College must accompany the official academic transcript. Course descriptions must come from the specific catalog year in which the course was taken and may be obtained from the college catalog where courses were taken.  All prerequisite courses must be completed with a minimum of "C" or better and the final grade must be posted on the transcript.

If an applicant has taken or will take the ATI TEAS at any location other than Santa Barbara City College, the applicant must request to have Assessment Technologies Institute (ATI) send the ATI TEAS transcript (score) to SBCC by going to their website at <a href="http://www.atitesting.com">www.atitesting.com</a> .  The ATI TEAS score is <b>required</b> at the time of application and must be received by the last day of the application period.  *An applicant who scores below 62% on the ATI TEAS exam will become ineligible for the current application cycle and must meet with the SBCC Program Director or designee to complete a remediation plan.
