0	 During your in-person or online advising session you will select your classes for your first semester. Include the appropriate level math and English courses in your academic plan If you assess below college level math or English consider joining the Express to Success Program (E.S.P.)

	 enrolling in <u>SS 101</u> - Intro to the Social Sciences or <u>BUS 101</u> - Introduction to Business
	 Consider taking honors courses through the <u>Honors Program</u>
	 If you are interested in a major in science, technology, engineering or math see if you qualify for the <u>S.T.E.M. Transfer Program</u> (S.T.P.) and take the STEM 101 course
	 Consider enrolling in a Personal Development (PD) course like <u>PD 100</u> – College Success or <u>PD 110</u> – Career Planning and Decision Making
